Blessings to all the Vicars, Sunday School Office bearers and the faithful of the Diocese of UK-Europe and Africa, in the name of the blessed Holy Trinity:

Dearly beloved in Christ,

With reference to the letter of His Holiness the Catholicos (Letter No.HES/HH/82/2023, dated 27-02-2023), I wish to inform you that the Northeast American Diocese, Southwest American Diocese, and our Diocese have been formed into one region to operate the Sunday School Association. In connection with this development, steps are being taken to bring uniformity in administration and curriculum. In alignment with this uniform pattern, please note that the post of Vice-President will be replaced with the role of Director, and henceforth, a clergy member of the Diocese will serve as the Sunday School Director.

We are blessed to witness an increase in the number of Sunday School students—thanks be to God—which necessitates further division into smaller zones for better administration. From 01 January 2025, the UK region will operate as five zones instead of the current three zones:

- 1. Scotland and Northeast Zone
- 2. North Zone
- 3. Central Zone
- 4. Southwest Zone
- 5. Southeast Zone

For the rest of the Diocese, the following zones will be operational:

- 6. Irish Zone
- 7. Central and Eastern European Zone
- 8. African Zone

The Sunday School Executive will soon publish the list of parishes comprising these zones.
