Blessings to all the Vicars and faithful of all the Parishes in the Diocese of UK-Europe and Africa in the name of the blessed Holy Trinity.

Beloved in Christ,

Following the pattern of the past years, I would like to remind you that we will observe the Feast of the Holy Cross (14 September) as the Diocesan Day. The Cross, being the symbol of salvation in Christ, calls us to thankfully acknowledge the redemption we have received through Him.

As all of us know, in order to hold the same pace and add momentum for the future, we face various challenges, particularly in financial matters. While we continue to keep intact the reserve fund from the sale of the Swindon property, the Diocesan Council and the Property Committee are prayerfully and actively searching for a suitable property to serve as our Diocesan Centre. For those Parishes where the Holy Qurbana (Eucharist) is not celebrated on 14 September, please ensure that the Diocesan Day is prayerfully observed on the next occasion when the Eucharist is celebrated.

May this Diocesan Day strengthen our unity in Christ, renew our commitment to the common cause of our Diocese, and deepen our witness to the Gospel.

May the intercessions of St. Mary the Mother of God, St. Thomas the Blessed Apostle, St. Gregorios of Parumala, and St. Dionysius be with us and strengthen us.
