To All Vicars, Trustees, Secretaries, Managing Committee Members of the Parishes, and the dearly beloved Faithful of the Diocese of UK-Europe and Africa,

I thank God Almighty for the fervent faith and commitment that each of you has displayed towards the well-being of our parishes. It is through this unwavering dedication that we continue to grow as a strong and spiritually vibrant diocese. Additionally, there are 75 members who contribute to the general account of the Diocese on a monthly basis, which remains the sole regular income that supports the functioning of our Diocese. I would like to take this opportunity to personally thank each of these generous contributors for their kind support.

I encourage you all to continue in prayer and to support this endeavor as we look toward the future with hope.

Your generosity has made a profound impact, and I am deeply thankful for your commitment to this cause.
